For Apparitors, Stewards, Ushers and Welcoming Ministries

Before Mass Begins

A) On Arrival

- 1. Arrive at Church at least 30 minutes before mass starts. Reserve yourself a seat by the door.
- 2. Special Masses
 - a) Palm Sunday long Gospel. Remind Priest to tell congregation to sit for it avoids collapses.
 - b) Christmas/Easter sweets for children. Remind Priest to distribute before dismissal.
- 3. Check sanctuary and church lights on control box by back chapel door.Where appropriate, turn on lights in main church top windows switch by side (wheel-chair) access door.
- 4. Open-up side door to allow wheel-chair access via ramp
- 5. Check sound system is on. Red light on right hand wall. Sacristan has key.
- 6. Where appropriate Move hymn book trolley out from the cloister corridor (take care it is heavy to pull) Ensure each hymn book has a bulletin in it.
- 7. In summer heat open windows to let cooler night air in & consider door opening.
- 8. Where appropriate hang notices on rear pillars inviting use of Blessed Sacrament Chapel.
- 9. Check outer door latch locked inwards.
- 10.Check internal side door and toilet doors open & latches locked inwards. Friars have key.
