

PLEASE – take care

Many who come to church are vulnerable to the current threat of infection. When churches were allowed to start admitting people with all due precautions our Health and Safety committee set up a very good barrage of precautions to protect all who come to St Thomas. For a time everyone cooperated in detail. But as time has worn on some are becoming careless. We, of all people, should be thinking of preventing any harm to come from our actions. So a reminder:

- All above the age of 11 wear a face covering.

- Please respect the one-way system in church.
