Saturday 24th May 2025 When:

As part of our celebration of the Jubilee Year, proclaimed by Pope Francis, which has as its theme "Pilgrims of Hope" the parish will be joining the Diocesan Pilgrimage to the Catholic National Shrine of Our Lady at Walsingham, in Norfolk. Parishioners last made such a pilgrimage in 2017 to celebrate the centenary of the Diocese of Brentwood.

We shall be travelling by coach from St. Thomas' on Saturday 24th May 2025. There are 55 places available on a first come first served basis. To encourage attendance we shall not be making a charge for places but invite parishioners to make a donation. The actual cost to the parish will be £20 per place.
