

Welcome back.

I hope you have all had some holiday, and come back refreshed for the new stage of our parish-family life. From tomorrow we begin a gradual return to the daily pattern of our services in church. The church will be open for visits each day from 8am to 6 pm We resume a daily mass at 10 am. We ask you to provide a reader and the priest will give communion, duly masked. On Sundays we will hear the three readings (still only 2 at 10am) and you will make and respond to your "prayers of the faithful".

With Caution

We are however very much aware of the rate of covid infection, still very high. And of our responsibility to keep you safe. Please do not abandon or relax the care and patience you have shown for many months. Still we ask you to wear a mask in church; register your presence for track and trace, sanitise your hands as you enter church. All the benches are once more in use. But PLEASE do maintain a safe distance from those not of your family bubble. Those who wish may take a card stating: *I am distancing* – just to alert those near to respect your private space. The windows will stay open. Social life elsewhere is returning to normal. Many of us feel too normal. Still social life is a large part of our parish practice. In two weeks time there will again be tea after the mass at 11.30 again spaced out safely.
